- **Grant closeout and final grantee performance report for the 2010 CA Housing and Community Development Disaster Recovery Initiative grant deliverables:**
 - Planning Documents that include: The updated Yurok Hazard Mitigation Plan that includes a Community Wildfire Protection Plan; a Yurok Safety Element with Emergency Land Use maps integrated into the document;
 - Rehabilitation grants for 48 homes upriver to seal the envelope of their homes from wildfire smoke that were impacted in the 2008 wildfires; and
 - Public service activities that purchased 2 HEPA filtration units for the Weitchpec and Morek Won and 59 HEPA filtration units for individual home owners in smoke impacted areas from the 2008 Wildfires
