Repaired a major water leak and putting in a new water heater for headstart building. Assisted with the remodeling of the bathroom and grounds at the Requa resort, and clear brush/vegetation from around the Klamath compound in addition to other daily duties.

The above activities are just a few things maintenance does. They also provide plumbing repairs in emergencies, paint,

trim trees, mow grass, set up and take down any function that the tribe has, moved furniture and boxes, change lights, put up shelves, and answer and fix any emergency that may and does come up.
