

YUROK TRIBAL FISHING RIGHTS ORDINANCE

Amendments adopted on August 26, 2011

SECTION 13(e): *Traditional Dispute Resolution*

Traditional dispute resolution provisions of this ordinance, such as those mentioned in Section 7(l), are limited to parties who are Yurok Tribal members and the Yurok Tribal Council specifically consents.

SECTION 13(f): *Exclusive Jurisdiction of Tribal Council on Certain Matters*

Notwithstanding any other provision of the fishing ordinance, any and all fishing disputes, claims of traditional or other rights, legal assertions, or controversies of whatever nature involving Native Americans who are not enrolled members of the Yurok Tribe will be decided by the Yurok Tribal Council.

THE FOREGOING AMENDMENTS TO THE YUROK TRIBAL ORDINANCE, ENTITLED THE YUROK TRIBAL FISHING RIGHTS ORDINANCE, WAS PASSED AT A REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF THE YUROK TRIBAL COUNCIL ON AUGUST 26, 2011 AT WHICH A QUORUM WAS PRESENT AND THAT THIS ORDINANCE WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF 7 FOR, AND 0 OPPOSED, WITH 0 ABSTENTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 4, SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE YUROK TRIBE.
