Also, if 41 you or someone you know needs assistance please contact YIHA they have funding to help with 42 back rent or utility bills.

44 Councilmember Hodge: These are trying times and everyone needs help. This Council is working really hard to help our membership.

Councilmember Williams: I've been working on the training program, its exciting to look at the potential jobs for our tribal members. I met with our Del Norte Superintendent and he is interested in working with our various departments to develop a career pathways for our tribal students.

Councilmember McCovey: I sit on a couple of different boards for the Tribe, including YAC and CDFI boards. One of the common things with both that needs better defined is when we need to develop MOU with the Tribe. I had my monthly UIHS and they are scheduling a special meeting to begin discussion with CRIHB; then they will meet with Tribal Governments. This Council has been having quite a few work sessions, and a lot of them have been about bringing people back to work safely. I had the opportunity to speak up at the USDA consultation meeting on broadband issues and how that's such a huge issue for Native American territories.
